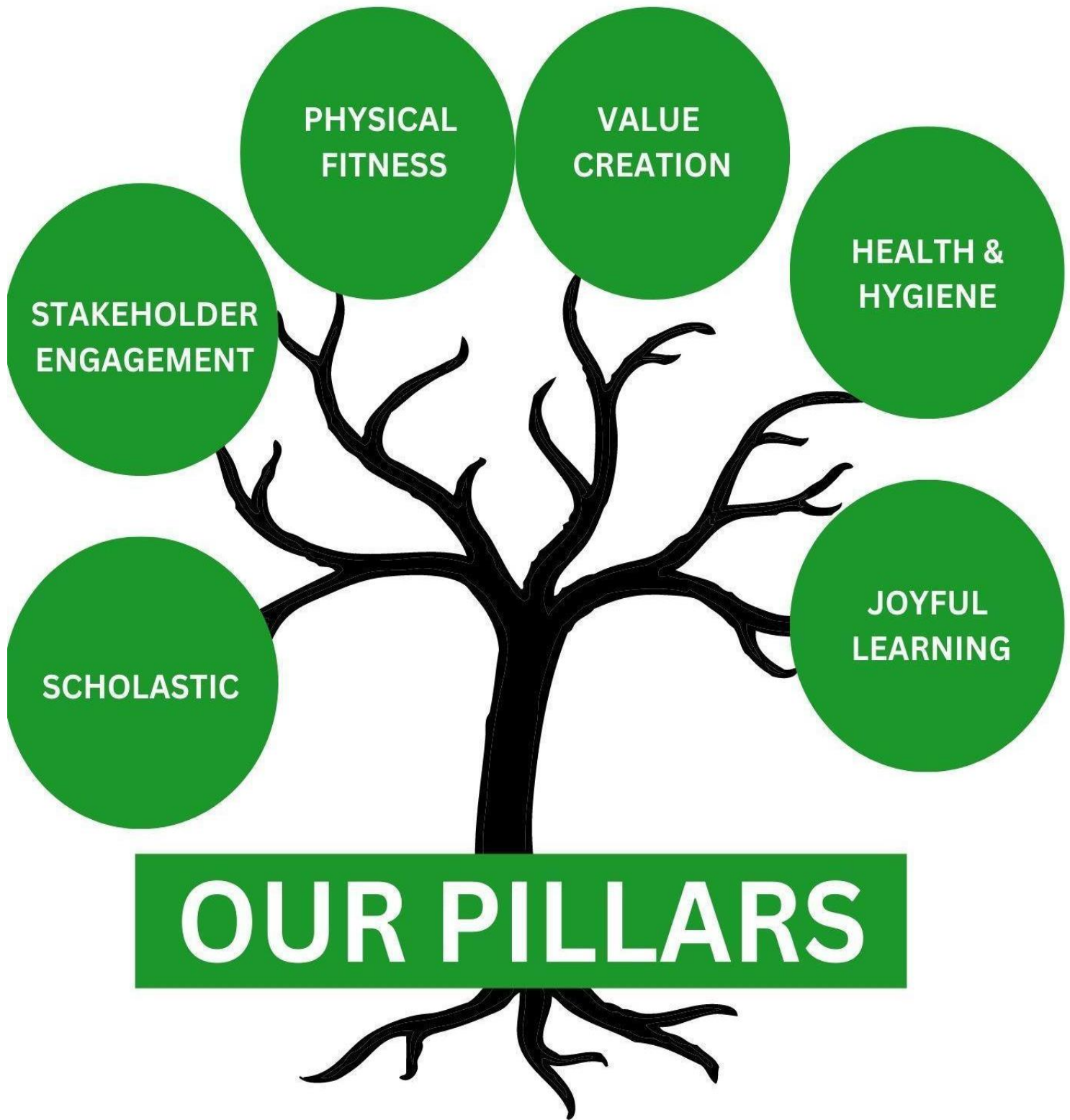

A noteworthy highlight of the quarter was the active involvement of parents in their child's education. Their commitment was evident through their participation in Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs), where they expressed their willingness to shoulder responsibility for their child's progress. This parental engagement is a crucial factor in ensuring holistic development and academic success.

Furthermore, our center had the privilege of hosting several volunteer visits from UKG as part of their CSR month. These volunteers generously dedicated their time to interact with our students, creating memorable experiences and fostering a sense of support and encouragement.

Additionally, we organized a Summer Camp in June, providing our children with a unique platform to explore their creativity and talents. Alongside imparting fundamental education, we continued our focus on teaching moral principles and essential life skills. Sessions on good behavior, habits, health, hygiene, and nutrition were conducted, further reinforcing our commitment to holistic development.

Throughout the quarter, ANK, remained dedicated to promoting the comprehensive growth of underprivileged children. By providing quality education and fostering an inclusive environment, we strive to empower these young individuals to overcome barriers and realize their full potential.



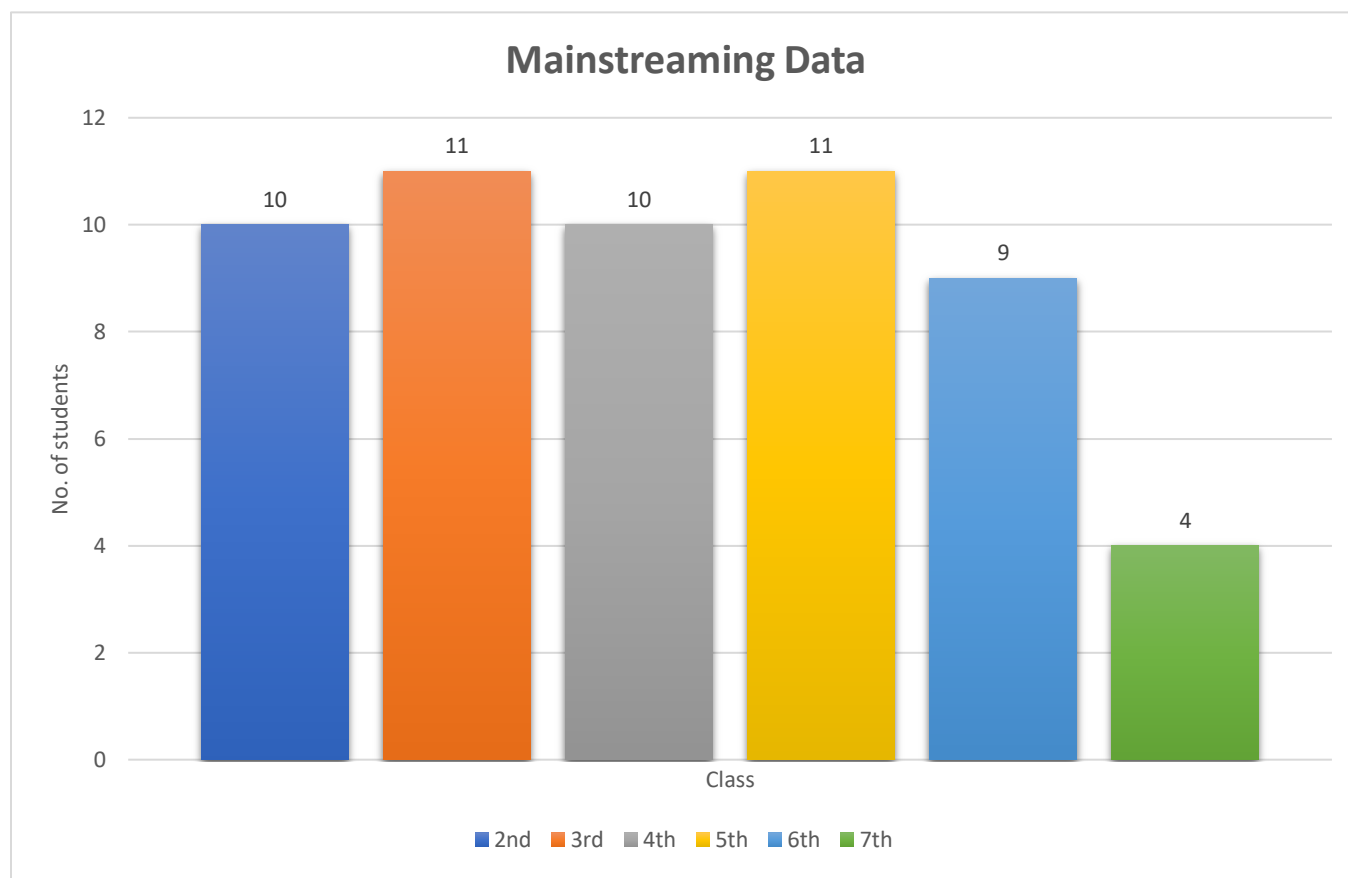
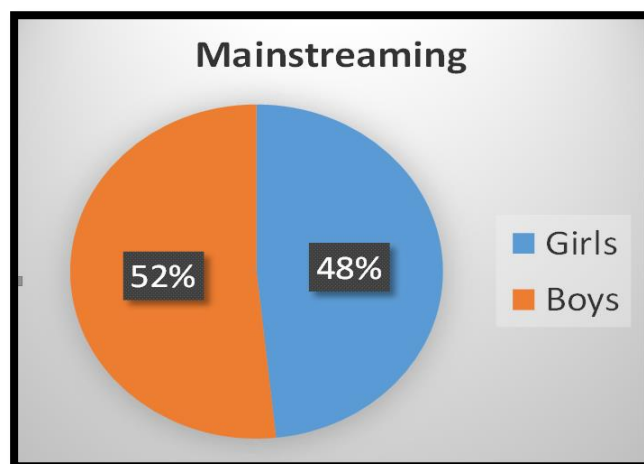
MAINSTREAMING

The focus of this quarter was on the mainstreaming of the out-of-school students of 2022-23 batch into Government Schools and mobilization of students for the next batch of 2023-24.

ANK's efforts resulted in an impressive mainstreaming rate of 100%. Of the 60 out-of-school students, 48% were girls and 52% boys.

One of the core objectives of ANK is to empower marginalized children by providing them access to quality education. In this quarter, we undertook the crucial task of mainstreaming our beneficiaries into government schools. The process involved transitioning children from our Learning Centre to mainstream educational institutions, enabling them to be a part of the formal education system.

As evident from the data, 70% students got admission in class between 2 & 5. The data signifies the effectiveness of ANK's educational programs, as well as the dedication of the staff members and volunteers who work tirelessly to facilitate the seamless transition of our beneficiaries. By mainstreaming these children, we have not only provided them with better educational opportunities but also encouraged their integration into the society.





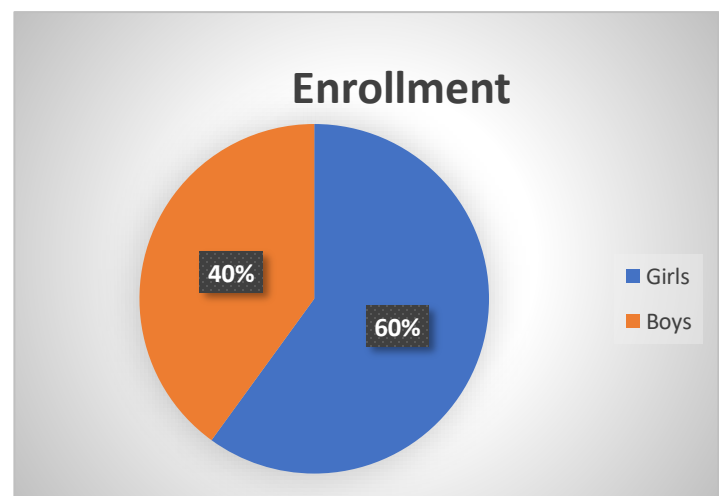
Mobilization and Enrollments

While the mainstreaming process of the past batch was going on, simultaneously, ANK initiated extensive mobilization to identify and enroll new students for the upcoming session. Recognizing the importance of reaching out to underserved communities, we proactively engaged with local communities, conducted awareness campaigns, and collaborated with community leaders to spread the word about our educational programs.



As a result of these efforts, we successfully enrolled 120 new students in the month of April. These children, who previously had limited or no access to formal education, are now provided with a platform to learn, grow, and develop their potential. The enrollment of these new students reinforces our commitment to expanding educational opportunities for the most vulnerable sections of society

As always, our team ensured more participation (enrolment) of female students. Thus, of the 120 students enrolled, 60% were girls and 40% boys.



Scholastic

Scholastic education plays a pivotal role in the early development of children, laying the foundation for their future academic and personal growth. During these crucial formative years, children's minds are receptive and absorbent, making it an ideal time to introduce them to the world of knowledge, skills, and learning.

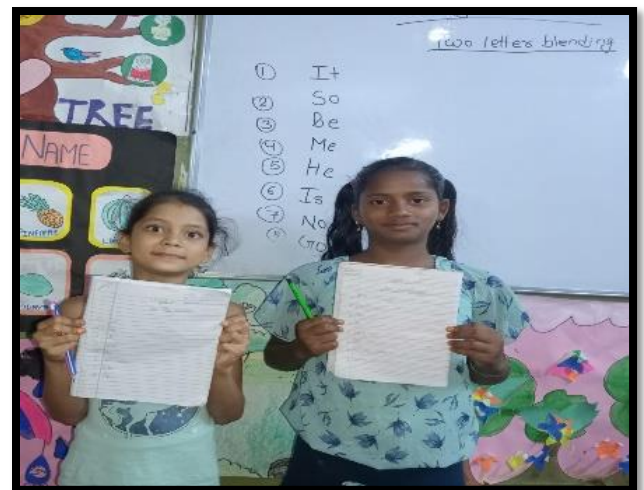

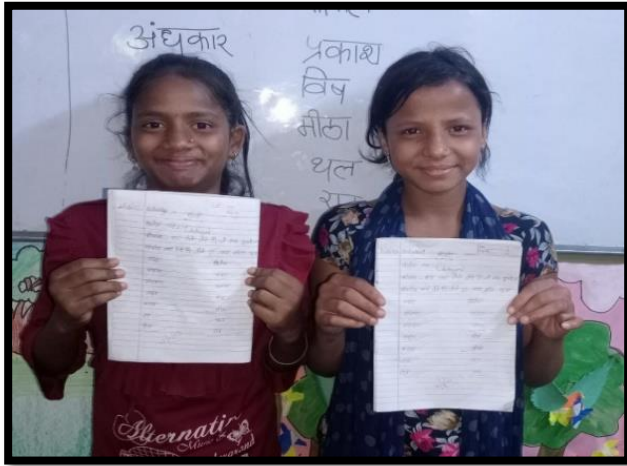
Activity- Importance of *Sorry* and *Thank you*



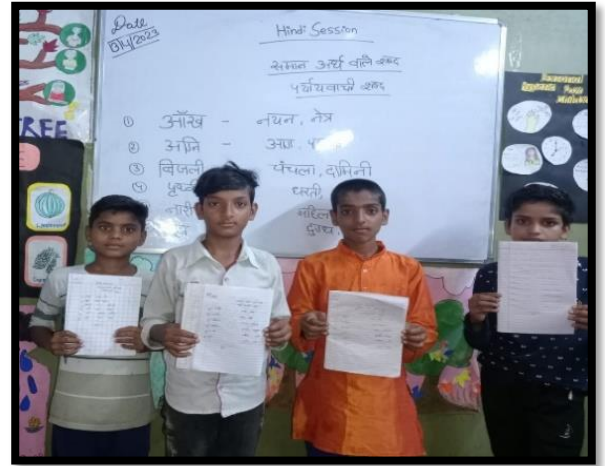
Activity- Two-letter blending

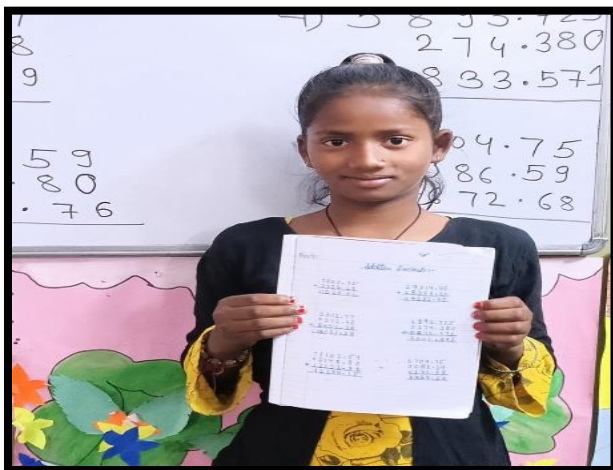

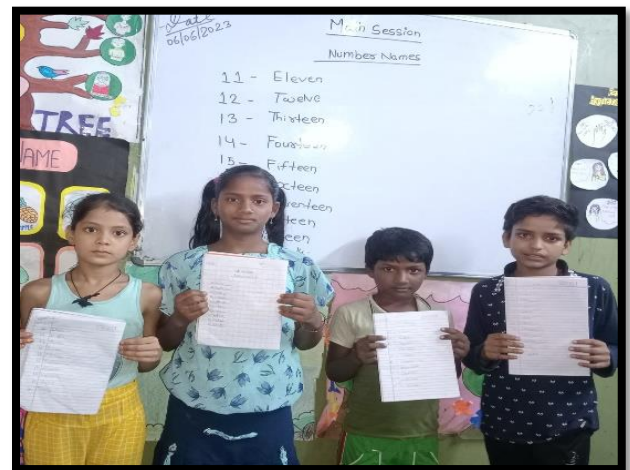

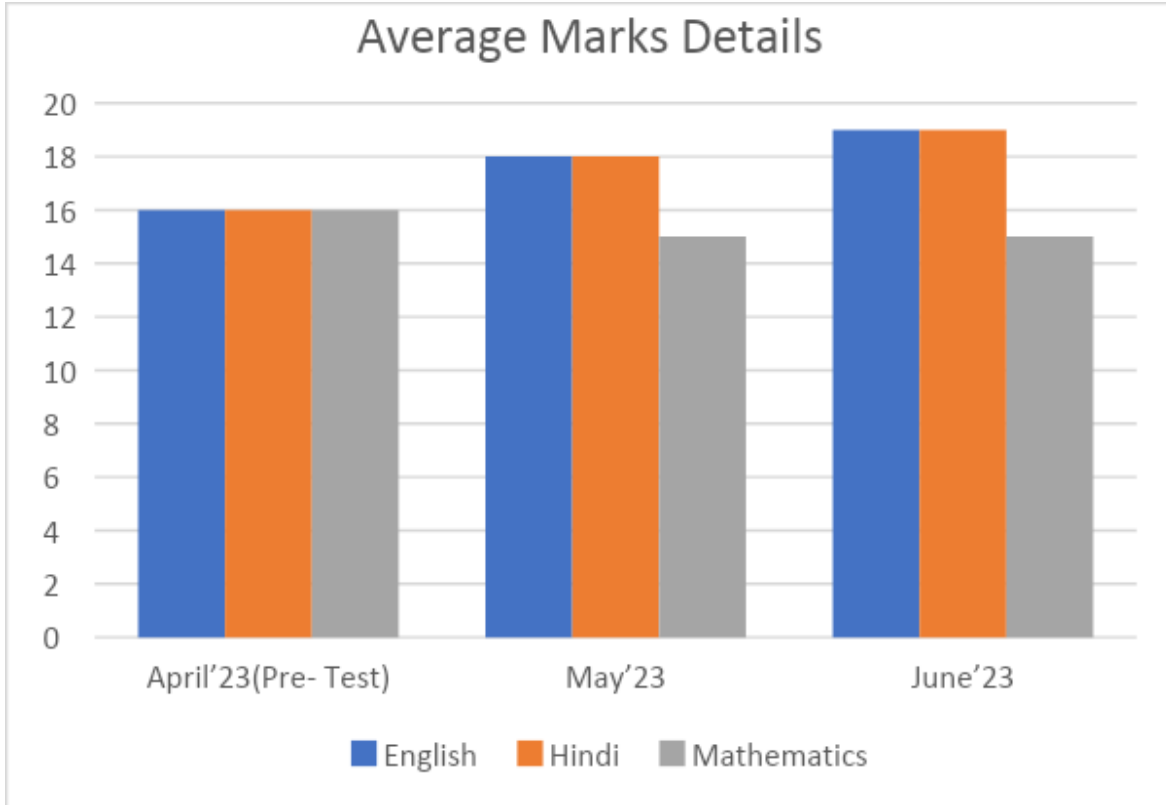
Monthly Test

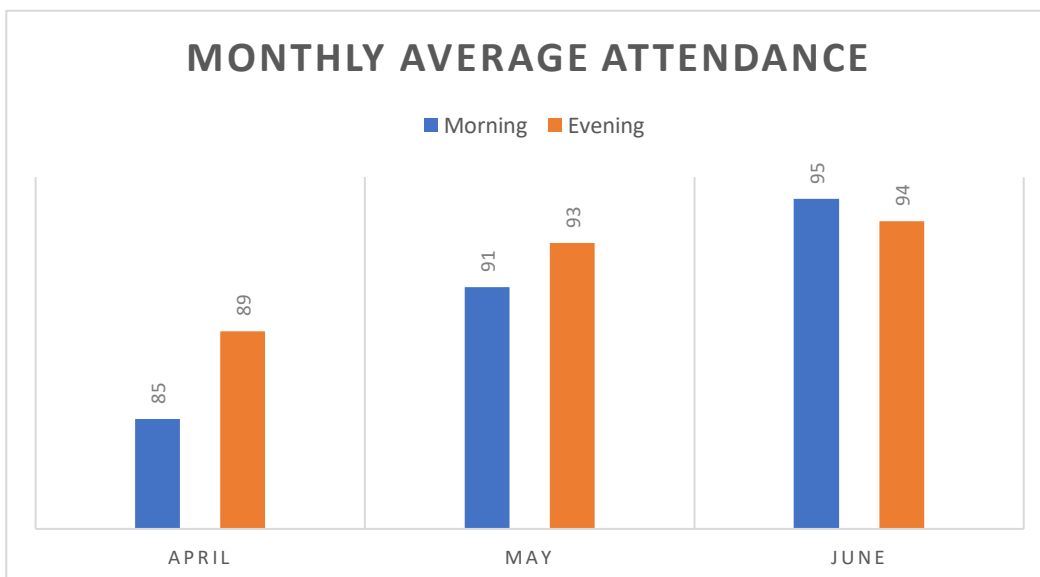
Personal Counseling

Parent's Teacher Meeting

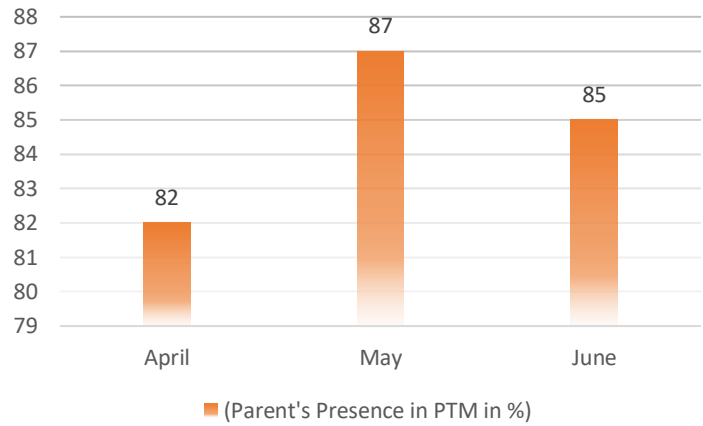

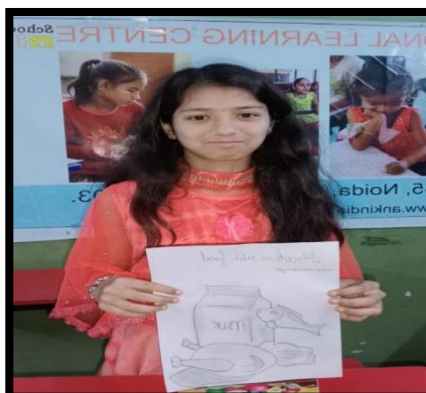
